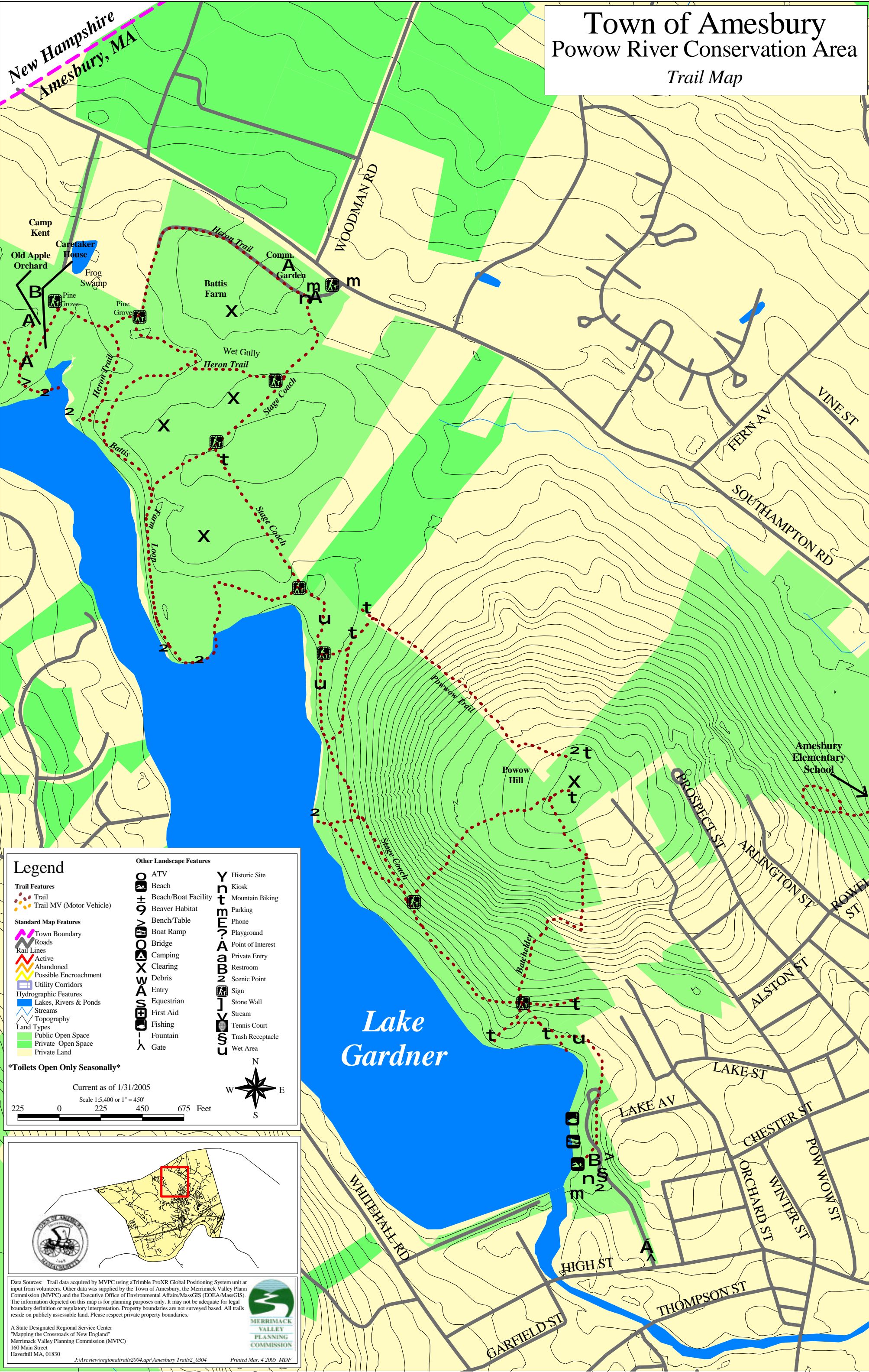


Town of Amesbury Powow River Conservation Area Trail Map

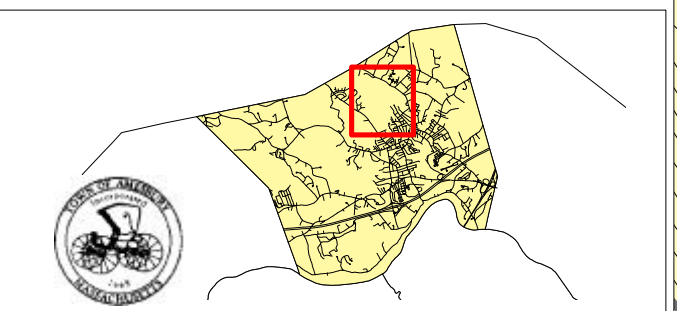
